## Tim Kopra CEO, Starlab

A seasoned executive and leader, Kopra is CEO of Starlab and Nanoracks (part of Voyager's Exploration Segment). Previously, he served as President of OneWeb Technologies, Vice President of Robotics and Space Operations at MDA, and Founder and Partner of Blue Bear Capital.
